

THE PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA (GDPR)

- 1.1. The protection of personal data of the buyer, who is a natural person, is provided by Act no. 101/2000 Coll., On Personal Data Protection, as amended and GDPR.
- 1.2. **The buyer agrees to the processing of his/her personal data: name, address, identification number, tax identification number, email address, telephone number (hereinafter collectively referred to as "personal data").**
- 1.3. The buyer agrees to the processing of his/her personal data by the seller for the purpose of the realization of rights and obligations under the contract (GDPR) and law regulation (archived invoice).
- 1.4. The seller may appoint a third party as processor for the processing of the personal data of the buyer. Apart from the persons transporting the goods, the personal data will not be passed on to third parties by the seller without the prior consent of the buyer.
- 1.5. The buyer confirms that the personal information is accurate and that he/she was made aware of the fact that he/she is providing the personal information voluntarily.
- 1.6. In the event that the buyer is under the impression that the seller or processor (Art. 1.4
 - 1.6.1. ask the seller or processor for an explanation,
 - 1.6.2. require the seller or the processor to rectify such a situation.
